A numerical variation of the well known rhyme: Little Miss Muffet sits on her tuffet as usual, but 'along came one spider / Who sat down beside her, / And said to Miss Muffet, / "Please stay!" So she stays, to be joined by two lemurs, three magpies, etc., all bearing streamers and food. The ten crocodiles who arrive last scatter the assembled crowd and give Miss Muffet a fright - 'Were they taking her back / In a box as a snack?' - but they've only come to complete the turnout at her surprise birthday party. Good fun, charmingly illustrated (even if the lemurs don't seem quite right!) and a welcome variation on the number book theme.
